Do you know what Shrove Tuesday is and what it has to do with Knights of Columbus Pancake Dinner?

The name Shrove comes from the old word "shrive" which means to confess. During Shrove Tuesday, in the Middle Ages, people used to confess their sins so that they were forgiven before the season of Lent began. Shrove Tuesday is celebrated the day before Ash Wednesday and is therefore the final day before the commencement of Lent. Lent is a time of abstinence, of giving things up leading up to Easter Sunday. On Shrove Tuesday, people indulge themselves on foods that traditionally are not allowed during Lent. Pancakes are eaten on this day because they contain fat, butter, and eggs, which were forbidden during Lent.
