**From Fr. Golas,**

Bishop Peter Rosazza, Auxiliary Bishop Emeritus of our Archdiocese, will be with us on the weekend of July 21/22 for our annual summer mission appeal. Bishop Rosazza will be seeking our help in raising funds for the Church of St. Antonio Galvao, in Brazil. A priest, Fr. Joao Bernardo in Taubate Diocese in the state of Sao Paulo is trying to build a church in a parish where he was recently assigned. Fr. Joao had ministered to the Brazilian communities in Hartford and Waterbury in our Archdiocese. Bishop Carmo Rhoden of the Taubate Diocese told Bishop Rosazza the community where the parish is located is poor with many social and religious problems.

The people of the parish are involved in raising funds for the Church. Some are asked to tithe \$5.00 a month. The parish also has fund raisers. The cost of building the church is \$64,000. As of today the foundation has been constructed. Bishop Rosazza will bring the architect’s photos with him on July 21/22. The Bishop’s Conference of our country has donated \$18,000 and the Archdiocesan Mission Office has donated \$5,000. Whatever we can donate will be a help. As a parish, we know what it takes to raise funds and build a new church. We can help St. Antonio Galvao Parish with their project. I hope you can be generous in responding to this need. I would be grateful. My thanks.

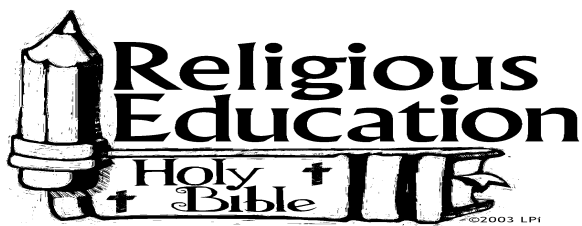
