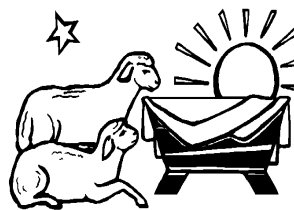
From Fr. Golas,
