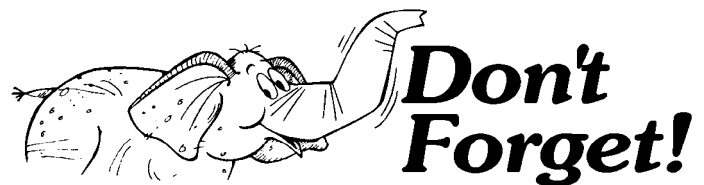

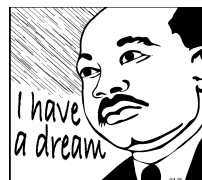


Upcoming Events
