Regulations during Lent about Fast and Abstinence

Abstinence from meat for those 14 years of age or over unless one is sick and fasting between the ages of 18 and 59 on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Abstinence from meat is observed on all Fridays of Lent. Fasting means one full meal a day, 2 light meals and no in-between meals.

The *focus question* for the Fourth Sunday "C" cycle February 3, 2013: *Who in your life needs to hear God's truth from you or who speaks God's truth to you?*

St. Mary's Parish Council Minutes for January 8, 2013 - continued

Women's Guild: The Guild's recent annual Christmas Party was a large success, with close to 60 women in attendance. The catered dinner featured entertainment by four members of the Valley Chordsmen. The next meeting of the Guild will be held on Tuesday, January 15, at 7:00. The evening's program will be a presentation by a member of the Fidelco Guide Dog Foundation.
Spring Music Festival: John Giovannucci of Two or More folk group submitted a proposal for SpiritFest, a festival sponsored by St. Mary's Youth Ministry consisting of faith-sharing, Christian contemporary music, fun and food for Catholic/Christian Youth and their families. The purpose of the event is to raise funds for a scholarship fund that would allow Catholic/Christian youth to

attend youth ministry activities such as SoulFest. After much discussion, it was decided that the event be organized on a smaller basis, and that a subcommittee be formed to formulate plans for a smaller event.

Nominations: Betty Faitella and Ed O'Reilly will assist Dick Selinga with the nominations process for new Council members. Dick will create a schedule and report back to the council at the March meeting.

Year of Faith/Catholicism DVD: Fr. Robert Barron's series *Catholicism* was presented to parishioners on December 3 and 10. Turnout was good for both sessions. The continuation of the series is tentatively scheduled for the five Mondays of Lent, with the exception of 3/11.

By-Laws: The Council discussed the revised by-laws. Additional changes were recommended. A motion to accept the revised by-laws, with changes made at the January Council meeting, was made, seconded, and passed. A list of parish committees lacking Council representation was distributed; Council members were invited to serve as liaison for one or more of the various church committees listed.

Meet & Greet Suggestions: The Building and Grounds Committee has met with electricians, who are currently gathering information regarding the lighting concerns in the lower parking lot. The decision was made to hold a second Wine and Cheese Social in April. Council members were asked to suggest ways in which parish newcomers might be welcomed. Following a discussion in which many ideas were presented, the Council decided to table the discussion until the March Council meeting. Council members were provided a draft copy of a Committee/Ministry Procedures document which will eventually be given to the various church committee heads.
