Those first disciples came to believe that Jesus is alive. In the Gospel of John today, we hear Mary of Magdala found the tomb of Jesus empty on that first Easter. She ran and told Peter and the other disciple whom Jesus loved about her discovery. They ran to the tomb to verify Mary’s story. At the end of the gospel we hear the other disciple went in the tomb and saw it and believed. The gospel is telling us about Easter faith and vision. This disciple realized something had changed. Jesus was no longer dead but alive. Those first disciples experienced the resurrection of Jesus as a strengthening of their faith and commitment to their Lord and Messiah. Today we celebrate our Easter faith and vision. May we recognize what our faith gives us – the hope of eternal life. May we have the vision to see how the Risen Lord is with us today in sacrament and in those around us. May the new life of Easter be visible in how we live each day for Christ. Happy Easter!
