**Eucharistic Adoration:** Concerns about declining attendance at Eucharistic Adoration liturgy were discussed. The suggestion to shorten the hours for First Friday liturgy will be considered.

**Buildings and Grounds:** Indoor church lights will be replaced with more energy-efficient LED lights in April.

**Human Needs:** Committee netted \$855 from sale of butter braids in January, with proceeds given to Meals on Wheels, Farmington Food Bank, and Burlington Food Bank. Soup and Bread meal was held on March 3 and netted \$400 for Catholic Relief Services. Food donations are requested throughout April for Food Pantry Month.

**Decorations:** Committee welcomes volunteers willing to help water the plants that decorate the altar at Easter.
