Recipes for Healthy Cleaners

All Purpose Cleaner Pour 3 tablespoons vinegar, 1 teaspoon borax and 2 cups hot water into a spray bottle. Shake until dissolved. Then add 1 teaspoon liquid soap (or dish washing liquid) to the bottle and shake it again. Spray on surface to be cleaned and wipe clean. For tough dirt, leave cleaner on for a few minutes and then wipe off.

Glass Cleaner- Pour 2 tablespoons of vinegar and 2 cups of water into a spray bottle. Add 2 drops of liquid soap (or dish washing liquid) and shake to mix. Spray on glass and wipe with lint-free cloth. Dry off with a second lint-free cloth.
