Buildings and Grounds: New LED lights will soon be installed in the church. The sod around the perimeter of the church and around outdoor lighting is being replaced with stone to eliminate the problem of lawnmowers hitting the church building and lighting.

Website: The Stations of the Cross which were on the website have been replaced with high resolution pictures of the stations that are in our parish church. The website continues to provide weekly updates of events and bulletins.

Scouts: The Cub Scouts held their annual Pinewood Derby on March 8 at New Horizons. The Blue and Gold Dinner was held on March 20. The scouts participated in the Town Clean-Up on May 4. The pack will be caring for a garden this summer at the Kolp Community Garden Plots; vegetables grown will be donated to the Farmington Food Bank.

Haitian Ministry: The ministry recently presented a program at the April 16 meeting of the Women's Guild. The ministry is in the process of planning a fundraiser to be held in the early fall, with proceeds to benefit either the Feeding Program or the Potty Program, two projects being undertaken at St. Therese Church in Lilavois, Haiti.
