Eucharistic Ministers: Three new members have joined the Eucharistic Ministry. Ed O'Reilly has accepted the position of sending out the schedules to all members of the ministry.

Fun: The combined Christmas Ornament Workshop and Knights of Columbus Children's Christmas Party was well attended. The committee will soon be planning for the upcoming Easter Egg Hunt.

Knights of Columbus: Msgr. Motta is the new chaplain of the Uncas Council, Knights of Columbus. The Knights held a successful Thanksgiving Social on 11/21.
