Parish Council Meeting Minutes**

Msgr. Motta provided the opening prayer, thanking God for a successful year and asking him for his continued blessings upon us and upon our parish.

Council President Dick Selinga welcomed new Council members, Terry Bonini, Ann Kerr and Lynne Murphy and Tom Goz.

On May 9, 2014, eight LEAP members attended an Earth Day-themed event and on May 10th, five DIVE members attended an Earth Day-themed event. Relay for Life took place on Saturday, May 17, 2014 and St. Mary's Building Blocks for Hope raised over \$1,000.00. Amanda thanked everyone who volunteered or donated.

There will be a Summer Social on June 7, 2014 for all Peer Connection families. Teen Weekend Retreat will take place from June 20 - 22, 2014 and is open to all high school students.

Soul Fest will take place from August 7—10 this year.

In September we will see Peer Connections Kick-off and the Catholic Youth Spectacular. More events can be found in a variety of spots, including: the parish website, Facebook page, bulletin board, monthly newsletter, e-vite invitations, and announcements in the bulletin.

The bulletin board in the Gathering Space will be updated monthly throughout the summer. A three-month Calendar of Events will be published and displayed on the Peer Connections bulletin board and on the parish website. Amanda and Andrew McCaffrey will be volunteering as part of the retreat team at Holy Family Retreat Center. Summer planning will include: Children's Liturgy Committee; Service Project Committee; and a committee of high school students that will plan and execute events for the younger children throughout the year. Other projects in the organization stage are an official youth group photographer. Another project would engage recently-graduated college students in becoming more active in parish life.

There was an Altar Server training session on May 18, 2014. Beginning in June, there will be four new altar servers. There will be a mandatory training session for all altar servers in the fall.

The Liturgy Committee will be meeting to discuss Holy Week and calendar events for next year. Msgr. Motta believes we will need a new person to schedule lectors, as our scheduler has retired from that position. *Minutes will conclude next weekend.*

The RCIA process takes place within the context of the parish community and after a suitable period of formation culminates in the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation -Baptism - Eucharist and Confirmation. Formation includes: **Scripture:** The stories of God's people. **Teaching:** What Catholics Believe. **Prayer:** How we communicate with God. **Liturgy:** How the community worships. **Mission:** How we live out what we believe. The RCIA process is also suitable for adults who were baptized Catholic - but have not yet received the Sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation.
