September 2, 2014 Parish Council Minutes continued....

The Legion has put a notice in the church bulletin stating that Legion members will visit and bring the Eucharist to parishioners who are homebound and unable to attend Liturgy.

In October the Legion is planning to place a statue of Our Lady of Fatima in the Gathering Space along with the Prayer Petition Box. On Sunday, October 19th there will be a Living Rosary in honor of Our Lady of Fatima. On Sunday, October 26th the Legion is sponsoring a Day of Reflection at Holy Family Monastery in West Hartford. It will feature a talk on Mary's faith.

The Legion plans to begin a Bereavement Program for people who have lost a loved one. It is hoped the program (The "New Day" Program) will start in October; it will be held on Wednesday mornings.

The Legion will be participating in a Patriotic Rosary on Sunday, November 2nd at 2:00 in the church.

Cub Scouts are getting started for the school year and will hold their first meeting on September 17th at West District School. Recruitment will start soon. There were 16 new Tiger Scouts last year. There will be a flag burning ceremony in the park across from Stop and Shop on September 11th.

The parish website was updated over the summer.

It was reported that the Archdiocese would like each parish to have an Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament sometime in September as respect to abortion. St. Ann's Parish in Avon will be contacted regarding a possible collaboration.
