Religious Education Registration

Registration for the “2015 – 2016” Religious Education year has begun. All new and returning students are required to submit a registration form. Forms will be placed in the entrances to the Gathering Space and Hart House. The normal registration period will end the weekend of **May 17th** after which a late fee will be imposed and class assignments made on a “space available” basis. Returning Home Study students (grades 3-8) will be re-assigned to the Home Study curriculum unless a change of status is indicated on the form at the time of registration. Those new to the program are asked to provide a baptismal certificate and evidence of completion of prior religious education so that a proper grade level assignment can be made.

A Pre-Baptism class for those who have not previously attended, will be held on April 21 at 7:00 p.m. in the Hart House. Please call the rectory to register. The next class will be held in June

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion Needed!

Lay persons who assist a celebrant (the ordinary minister) in distributing Holy Communion are known as extraordinary ministers. At St. Mary's about 40 lay people participate in the sacred ministry of Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMoHC). Those who participate regard it as a privilege, a commitment to serve the parish, and an opportunity to grow spiritually.

EMoHC's are usually scheduled for the Mass of their preference and typically serve at last two times a month. Some EMoHC's may also be called to serve members of our parish community who are unable to attend Mass due to sickness and physical hardships. Volunteers for this ministry must be practicing Catholics and be approved by the pastor. New volunteers must attend a one-day workshop on spiritual and theological topics conducted by the Archdiocese and attend a practice session.
