**Parish Council Bulletin Minutes—March 11, 2015**

Msgr. Motta provided the opening prayer by asking God for his continued blessings on our church and on all our Parish Activities and to help us be good disciples.

A Retreat for the Confirmation class will take place on March 22<sup>nd</sup> at Holy Family Monastery. Confirmation is scheduled for April 27<sup>th</sup>.

Training for altar servers will take place on Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup>. There are currently 22 altar servers in the program. Six altar servers will be needed for Confirmation. Servers are also currently being scheduled for Holy Week, Easter Sunday and Divine Mercy Sunday using the website SignUp Genius.

In January, 32,000 meals were packaged at the “End Food Hunger Packaging Event,” with donations of time and funding from parishioners. The meals will be distributed to Gifts of Love, Food Share, and the Farmington and Burlington food banks. In March, movie night will be about unconditional love. April will bring the Spring Fundraiser and the start of the Children’s Worship Ministry. Relay for Life will take place in May. Teen Weekend Retreat is scheduled for June 19<sup>th</sup> through the 21<sup>st</sup>. Soul Fest will take place in August.

The youth ministry newsletter has been reformatted with a new design, less announcements and more content. The Facebook page is updated each Sunday with the Gospel and a relating graphic or artwork.

The mission of the new Children’s Worship Ministry is to educate 3 to 6-year-olds about the mass and our Catholic faith. The program is created to focus on the Gospel through readings that are child-centered and activities and music to reinforce the Gospel message and will follow the structure of the mass. The coordinator for this ministry is Danielle Frissora. Children’s Worship Ministry will begin on April 12<sup>th</sup> and run through June 28<sup>th</sup> during the 9:30 mass

Liturgy Committee meetings will be held once a month in the Hospitality Room after the 11:00 mass. Discussion continues as to the responsibilities that currently fall under the Liturgy Committee. The next meeting will take place on March 22<sup>nd</sup> after the 11:00 mass.

The Finance Committee may begin putting funds aside in a reserve fund for church upkeep and repairs. For example, this year alone \$18,000 was spent on snow removal. The Building Committee will begin assembling numbers regarding upkeep and repair.

The Human Needs Committee had their Butter Braid and Cookie dough fundraiser in January. On March 15<sup>th</sup>, the committee will sponsor its annual Soup and Bread meal to benefit Catholic Relief Services. In April, they will be collecting donations for the Farmington and Burlington Food Banks.

An ice dam on the west wall of the church caused a leak and subsequent ceiling damage in the Reconciliation room; the damage was repaired by a roofing contractor. Dave Popielarczyk donated his time and talents to install additional shelving in the storage closets in the Gathering Space and he charged the church only for supplies. Mr. Popielarczyk is also making a new Paschal Candle stand which will include wheels, enabling easier movement of the candle down the main aisle of the church.

On Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> there will be a Corned Beef Dinner at the K of C. A \$5.00 donation is requested, as well as an appetizer or dessert.

Sandy Purrier has stepped down as Chairperson for the Decorations Committee. Two volunteers have come forward to take over.

The Fun Committee is planning the Annual Easter Egg Hunt for Saturday, April 4<sup>th</sup>.

The Women’s Retreat is scheduled for March 14<sup>th</sup>.

**Religious Education News****Religious Education Registration**

Registration for the “2015 – 2016” Religious Education year has begun. All new and returning students are required to submit a registration form. Forms will be placed in the entrances to the Gathering Space and Hart House. The normal registration period will end the weekend of **May 17<sup>th</sup>** after which a late fee will be imposed and class assignments made on a “space available” basis. Returning Home Study students (grades 3-8) will be re-assigned to the Home Study curriculum unless a change of status is indicated on the form at the time of registration. Those new to the program are asked to provide a baptismal certificate and evidence of completion of prior religious education so that a proper grade level assignment can be made.
