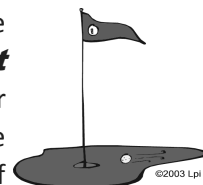
This weekend our parish will take up the Catholic Relief Services Collection. Thank you for your support. The second collection next weekend is the monthly offering.

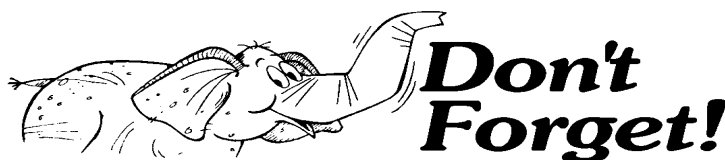
