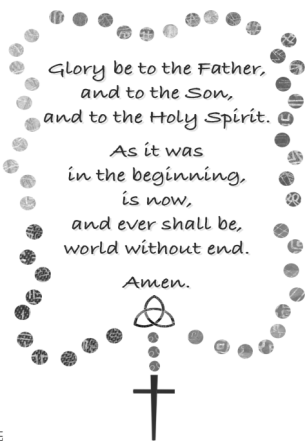
Classes for the 2016/2017 religious education year are scheduled to begin on Sunday, October 2nd.
