**From Daniel Cardinal DiNardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston, President, United States Conference of Catholic Bishops:**

In the past few days Hurricane Irma devastated significant parts of the Caribbean and the southeastern United States. While emergency outreach was immediate, we know that the road to recovery and the rebuilding of communities will be long and additional support will be needed. I write to you and ask that you take up an emergency collection for those impacted by Hurricane Irma. I am aware that this call comes on the heels of the emergency collection for Hurricane Harvey.
