June Saints of the Day**June 1 – Saint Justin, Martyr**

Justin was born around the year 100 in Samaria, a Palestinian province. Justin gave explicit written descriptions of the early Church's beliefs and its mode of worship which are continued in the traditions of the Catholic Church today: he described the weekly Sunday liturgy as a sacrifice, he speaks of the Eucharist as the true body and blood of Christ.

June 5 – Saint Boniface, Bishop and Martyr

St. Boniface, a monk of Exeter in England, is one of the great people of the Benedictine Order and of the monastic apostolate in the Middle Ages. Pope Gregory II sent him to Germany where he evangelized many and became Archbishop of Mainz. He was named the Apostle of Germany, and Catholic Germany in our own times still venerates him as its father in the faith. He was put to death in 754 during the last of his missionary journeys to what is now the Netherlands. The famous abbey of Fulda, where his body lies, has remained the national shrine of Catholic Germany.
