**October 18: Feast of Saint Luke, Evangelist** - Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John are considered the original Evangelists. However, did you know that Luke is also considered to be the author of the *Acts of the Apostles*? Combined, *Acts* and the *Gospel of Luke* comprise a significantly large portion of the New Testament, more than anyone else.

Luke is believed to have been born in Antioch, Syria, became a follower and close friend of St. Paul, and was martyred in Greece in 84 AD. He was most likely a doctor and was certainly an educated man of his time. A debatable theory is that he was the only gentile (non-Jewish) author of the Gospels: based on his Greek heritage, clues in his text, and in how Paul refers to him in Paul's writing. Some famous parables of Jesus are only found in Luke's Gospel, such as the Good Samaritan and the Prodigal Son. Another unique feature of Luke's Gospel is the focus on Jesus' journey to Jerusalem to face the opposition Jewish leaders and His eventual fate on the cross to lions in a public spectacle.

**UPDATE re ARCHDIOCESAN SYNOD 2020:**

Following our parish's own Listening Session on 8/8/18, a detailed 12-page report was submitted to the Archdiocese. Subsequently, the Archdiocese requested parish representatives attend a Deanery Listening Session with Archbishop Blair on 9/28/18. Jim & Sue Shortley, Lynne Murphy and Amanda McCaffrey attended. Lynne spoke on many of the issues submitted in our parish report. Updates will follow whenever more information is provided by the Archdiocese.
