Religious Education Registration

Registration for the "2019 – 2020" Religious Education year has begun. **All new and returning students are required to submit a registration form.** Forms can be found in the entrances to the Gathering Space and Hart House. The normal registration period will end **June 14th** after which time tuition fees will increase and class assignments made on a "**space available**" basis only.

Returning Home Study students (grades 3-8) will be re-assigned to the Home Study curriculum unless a change of status is indicated on the form at the time of registration.

Those new to the program are asked to provide a baptismal certificate and evidence of completion of prior religious education so that a proper grade level assignment can be made.

Meal Packing Fundraiser

113 cases of nutritious, fortified meals of both rice and beans, and pasta with tomato basil sauce were packed on Saturday, May 4 in the Gathering Space. Hartford county is the 4th hungriest in New England and our efforts will impact many people. In our 3rd year, we increased the amount of meals and the number of recipients again! The food was donated to 24 local food pantries and agencies: FISH, Torrington; The Fresh Place, Hartford; Seventh Day Adventist Church Food Pantry, Plainville; Gifts of Love; Fern Street Back Pack Program; Universalist Church, West Hartford; United Labor Agency Backpack Program, Rocky Hill; St. Augustine's Church, Hartford; The Cathedral of St. Joseph Food Pantry; Agape House, Bristol; Salvation Army, Bristol; The Friendship Center, New Britain; McKinney Shelter, Hartford; Zion Evangelical Lutheran, Bristol; H.O.M.E. Maine; Town Food Pantries of Avon, Burlington, Canton and Farmington; Loaves & Fishes, Hartford; St. Vincent DePaul, Bristol; Bristol Center High School; The Catholic Worker, Hartford; Hispanic Health Council, Hartford; House of Bread, Hartford. Many volunteers worked very hard on Saturday from 11:00 to almost 4:00. This work is made possible by generosity and dedication to helping our neighbors. Four sponsor organizations contributed—St. Mary's Women's Guild, Knights of Columbus, Farmington UNICO and Unionville Lions Club. Over \$6,000 was raised to fund the supplies provided by the Outreach Program. Each meal costs .25 which feeds 4—6 people; one case costs \$54. Thank you to the small but mighty team of parishioners who planned and coordinated this service project—Lynda Bonato, Pat & Bob Cables, Jan & Ed Crowe, Joanne Fishman and Ann Rourke.
